Report of Belize as Depositary of the Statute Establishing the Small Island Developing States Dock (SIDSDOCK)

29th September, 2018
New York

1. The instrument establishing the Small Island Developing States DOCK, (SIDSDOCK Statute) was opened for signature at the Third International Conference on Small Island States in Apia, Samoa from 1st to 5th September 2014. It remained open for signature at the Permanent Mission of Belize to the United Nations in New York acting on behalf of the Government of Belize as Depositary of the Statute until its entry into force.
2. The SIDS Dock entered into force on 27th September 2015 being the thirtieth day after the date of deposit of the ninth instrument of ratification.
3. Accordingly, on 29th September 2015, Belize submitted the SIDSDOCK Statute to the United Nations Treaty Section in New York for registration pursuant to Article 102 of the Charter of the United Nations. A certificate confirming registration as of 1 February 2016 was issued on 3 June 2016 and is attached hereto as Annex 1.
4. The SIDSDOCK Statute remains open for ratification or accession at the Permanent Mission of Belize to the United Nations in New York. The Statute currently has 20 signatories and a total of 16 state Parties. A table of the status of the Statute is attached hereto as Annex 2.
